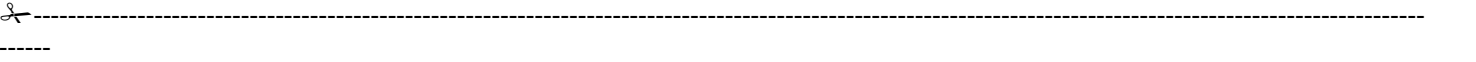
If you would like your Son to attend the cost will be £ 36 which should be paid by 30th June

ALL ITEMS TO BE LABELLED CLEARLY WITH BOYS NAME

General Notes

1. We would ask for your son to travel in Cub Uniform
2. Black bin bags are not suitable for bedding rolls as they tear very easily, with the result that the contents get lost or soiled in transit.
3. Please place wash proof name labels in all clothing, which should have your son's name and group.
4. No games or similar items (i.e. Radio's or Cassette players. Nintendo's etc which require batteries to run please.)
5. NO MOBILE PHONES OR ELECTRONIC GAMES!

Equipment Notes

Sleeping bags	Synthetic filled bags are easier to clean than natural filling.
Torch	Do not pack torch with batteries fitted (or at the bottom of your kit) as it could easily get accidentally turned on.
Ground Sheet	This is a strong plastic sheet that is larger than the size of the sleeping bag.
Cups and Plates	These should be none breakable and made identifiable.
Packing Kit	Put inside plastic bag this helps keep kit dry.
